Our Business

Tradewise Insurance Services Ltd is an established Managing General Agent (MGA) based in the UK providing insurance to UK based residents. We are authorized and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority.

Our Supply Chain

We deal with various Third Parties including facility companies and following relevant risk assessment, it has been established that the risk of modern slavery in our supply chain as far as we can be aware is very minimal. We do however recognize the importance of this Act and regularly review this within due diligence checks.

Our Employees

Our Employees are all issued with a contract of Employment that sets out their contractual rights i.e. paid annual leave, hours etc. Employees also have access to a range of benefits that includes a health insurance policy providing a range of assistance for various health matters and helplines.
